

## **Invest and be a minyannaire!**

The new and improved (we hope) OJC minyan system will soon go into effect. Over the last several months your rabbis have been reaching out to congregants inviting them to opt into or opt out of our minyan calendar. By ***opting in***, you commit to a specific day (or more) of the monthly calendar, with the understanding that you will receive an automated phone call from Rabbi Scheff reminding you of your commitment. Naturally, we hope you will join us for minyan as often as possible, but in this way we can rely on your commitment for the night(s) you choose.

Should you ***opt out***, you will not receive phone calls from the OJC regarding minyan attendance except for the courtesy reminder call we make when you have a *yahrzeit* to be observed. Naturally, your opting out doesn't preclude you from joining us for a minyan any time you are so moved; it just means we won't be counting on you to be there at any given time. If the rabbis haven't called you yet, and you haven't opted in or out, please e-mail the rabbis with your preference so we can complete our monthly calendar. If you opt in, tell us which night of the month you choose (e.g., "the third Tuesday" or "the second and fourth Wednesdays"); if you opt out, we'll understand that a regular commitment is not possible at this time.

Hopefully, in the very near future (perhaps by the end of December), the automatic dialer will be loaded with our calendar, you'll receive a message that we have begun the new system, and the calendar of invested minyannaires will commence!
